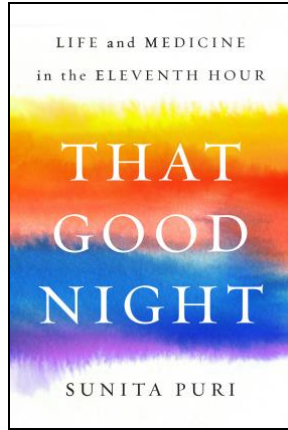


Talking Books
