### **About the Workshop**

**Probing Peculiar Plants** Saturday, 4/15/2023 @ 3 pm – 4:30pm

During the 90-minute workshop, Denise Sfraga will give a presentation of strange and peculiar plants from around the world - the kind you don't normally see at your local garden center. Some examples of the plants she will include are White Baneberry (Dolls Eyes), Hydnora Africana (Jackal Food), Calceolaria Uniflora (Happy Aliens), Hydnellum Peckii (Devil's Tooth), Titan Arum (Corpse Flower) as well as many others. Using presentation images as inspiration and their imagination, participants will create an 8x6" drawing of their own wacky and weird plant world using an array of materials, including markers, colored pencils, stencils, and crayons.
