Asian American Authors in Conversation: Cecily Wong Wednesday, June 21, 6:00 PM

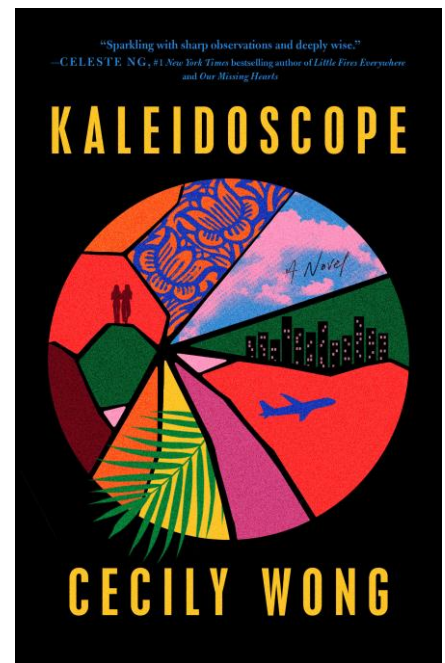
